

Sports Premium Report 2015-16

Sports Premium Funding is allocated to schools to improve the provision of Sport in Primary schools and is based on the number of pupils. Southern Road received a total of £10,685 in the academic year 2015/16. The following report explains how we are using the funding.

Activity	Explanation and Impact
Cumberland School Sports Partnership work	<p>CPD support - Programme of CPD courses for P.E. leaders, class teachers and support staff. Inset sessions on problem solving for all staff.</p> <p>Various intra and inter-school competitions - which include multi-sport games, multi-skills, skipping, dance mats and athletics competitions between Newham schools. Mini-Olympics, tri-golf, futsal amongst others.</p> <p>Inclusive Sports Programme - coaching in Paralympic sports (goalball, boccia, New Age curling, seated volleyball)</p> <p>Sports Club Coaching - support for N.Q.Ts and new staff and coaching in various sports including archery.</p> <p>Sports Leaders Training - Year 5 & 6 sports leaders trained to lead competition and playground activities</p> <p>Impact – Pupils receive good/outstanding PE lessons from well-trained school staff and will have had opportunities to take part in sporting competitions</p>
Dance CPD	<p>To support the class teachers in the delivery of dance, focussing on the breakdown of techniques and specific skills and promoting healthy lifestyles.</p> <p>Led by a specialist dance coach, modelling for the class teachers— one hour per week, per class for one term.</p> <p>Pupils also offered the chance to take part in lunch time and after school clubs, to consolidate and extend their learning, as well as promoting a healthy lifestyle.</p> <p>Impact – Staff will be confident in the teaching of dance leading to pupils achieving a good standard in dance.</p>
Extra-curricular activities	<p>Extending extra-curricular activities and promoting a healthy lifestyle including Cheerleading Club offered to Years 3 & 4.</p> <p>Impact - the quality and quantity of extra-curricular sports activities has been improved</p>
Planning / Resources	<p>New differentiated curriculum resources and activity cards introduced to support PE learning</p> <p>Equipment replenished and extended. New equipment bought includes spring boards and mats for gymnastics.</p> <p>Impact – enhanced PE experiences for pupils leading to higher achievement.</p>
