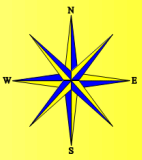

We also had some fantastic news this week linked to reading. You may be aware that Plaistow Library run 'The Summer Reading Challenge' every year. This year was their best and most popular competition to date.

In the Summer 2,314 children entered from schools across the Plaistow neighbourhood with 632 children successfully completing the challenge. Of this, Southern Road Primary school had 260 children join with 244 children successfully completing the challenge. This meant that we were this year's SRC winners! A local councillor will present the school with the trophy soon and all children that completed the challenge will also receive a certificate. Well done to all!

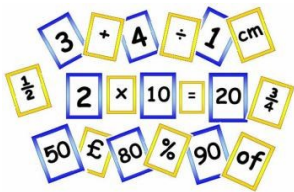


National Young Mathematician
