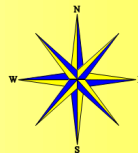

Visit to the Royal Albert Hall

On Tuesday 30 Year 5 and 6 pupils enjoyed a visit to the Royal Albert Hall to take part in an interactive Maths and Music workshop in order to gain a greater understanding of how music can help us explore fractions, decimals, percentages and probability.

The session began with exploring rhythm using iPads which led to creating a piece of music using percussion instruments, a drum kit software and probability. This was after the children calculated the fraction, percentage and decimal fractions of the sounds made in a pulse of 8. Things got even more exciting when we were invited into the arena to observe Cirque de Soleil during rehearsals for their evening performance.
