Jeffrey (5LV) with 0.66s

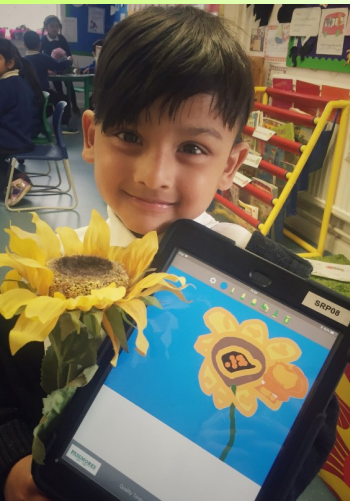
Jerry (5MD) with 0.77s

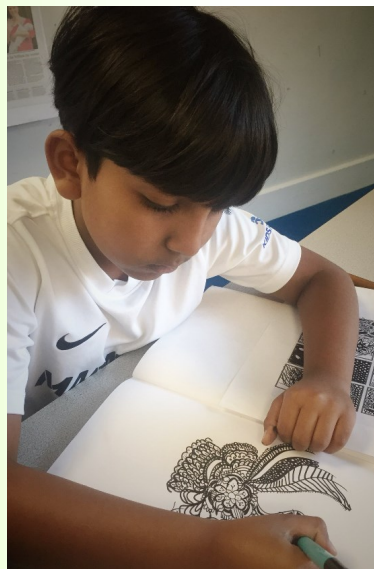

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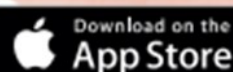
