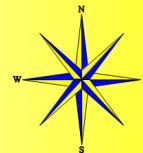

Jeffrey (6AS) and Nathaniel (6TB) and Arjun (6AS) - all with 0.44s!

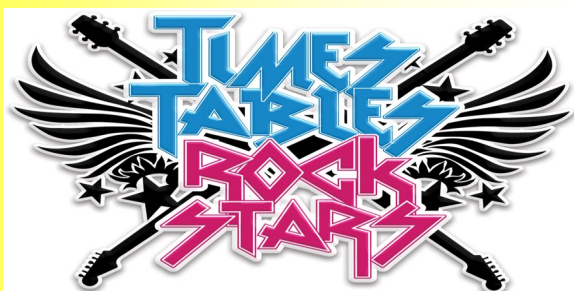
Khadija (6TB) and Rana (6AS) - both with 0.47s!
