We are pleased to announce that the posters designed by our children are now part of the touring exhibition organised by Roma Support Group.

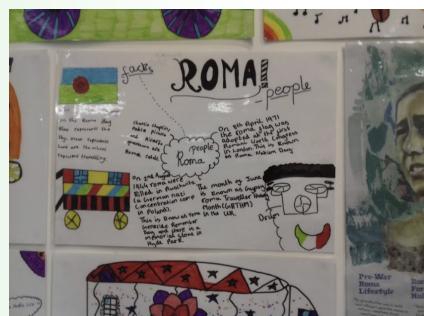
