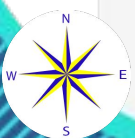

# Begins next week: Monday 28th June

## A HEALTHY SCHOOL STREET FOR SOUTHERN ROAD PRIMARY SCHOOL

Healthy School Streets aim to make it healthier and safer for children to walk, cycle or scoot to school and to create more space for social distancing.

**From** June 28 2021, **Carter Road, St Mary's Road, Queen's Road (between Western Road and Queen's Road West), Queen's Road West, Southern Road (between Edinburgh Road and Western Road), Northern Road, Eastern Road, Junction Road, Samson Street (between Old Street and Southern Road), Kings Court, Prince Terrace, Queens Terrace, Plaistow Park Road and Watson Street** will become pedestrian and cycle only zones at school drop-off and pick-up times.

**This is between 08:00 - 09.30am and 14:30 - 16:30pm, Monday to Friday during term time only.**

Only residents who live on these roads, black cabs and emergency services will be able to drive here during these times.

With less traffic on the roads children will breathe cleaner air, feel more comfortable crossing the road and will be able to enjoy an active and healthy journey to school. At the same time, there will be more space for parents and carers to socially distance safely while waiting.

Remember to walk, cycle or scoot to school if you can!

We encourage everyone to consider an alternative way to travel but if you need to drive to get to school, you will need to park nearby or arrive outside the times of restrictions.
