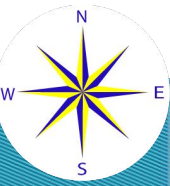
I would like to wish our amazing Year 6 pupils all the best for the future. The graduation event was a fitting end to their time here at Southern Road and we will miss them all greatly.

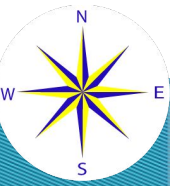


