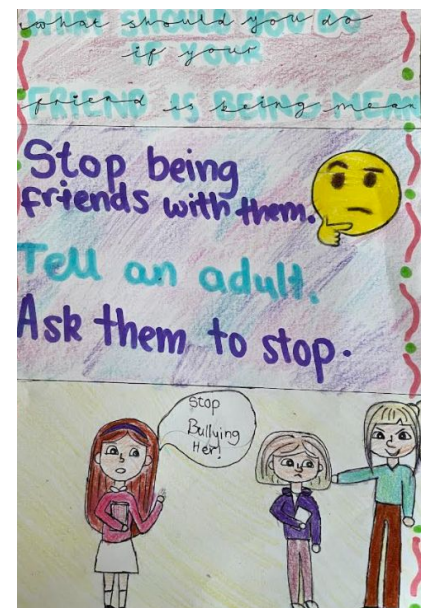

## Cody Dock Visit

Twenty representatives from Year 5 attended 'The Story of Water' celebration at Cody Dock, an environmental outdoor centre situated in Canning Town. It was a glorious sunny day, to be part of an important campaign about the impact of pollution on a global level.

The children and teachers from Southern Road and four other schools involved in the project were shown around the site. They were amazed to see all their artwork exhibited on the environmental theme of plastic pollution and saving our rivers, seas and oceans. Sea creatures created from recycled plastic bottles were hung in an open gallery. Eye catching protest placards, Ghanaian weaves and non chronological reports were reproduced in photographic form and hung along an outdoor corridor and on long panels.
