FREE EARLY EDUCATION AND CHILDCARE FOR 2, 3 AND 4 YEAR OLDS

Do you have a 2, 3 or 4-year old child? Don't miss out!

2-year old early education and childcare - 15 hours free per week

Eligibility criteria applies.

3 and 4-year old early education and childcare - 15 hours free per week

All 3 and 4-year olds are entitled to this. Register with an approved provider so your child can start from the term after their 3rd birthday.

3 and 4-year old early education and childcare - 30 hours free per week

For 3 and 4-year olds with working parents. Eligibility criteria applies.

IF YOU HAVE A 2, 3, OR 4-YEAR-OLD CHILD, YOU COULD BE ENTITLED TO FREE EARLY EDUCATION AND CHILDCARE. YOU COULD GET:

2-YEAR OLD EARLY EDUCATION AND CHILDCARE - 15 HOURS FREE PER WEEK

Your 2-year-old can get 15 hours per week free early education and childcare if you receive certain benefits. Household income thresholds apply to some benefits in the criteria.

Your child may also qualify in their own right. Children can start the term after their second birthday.

To check eligibility, please visit www.newham.gov.uk/twoyearold and complete the quick and easy online checker.

3 AND 4-YEAR OLD EARLY EDUCATION AND CHILDCARE - 15 HOURS FREE PER WEEK

All 3 and 4-year-olds are entitled to 15 hours a week free early education. Children can take up a place from the term after their third birthday at an approved provider of your choice. A list of providers is available at www.newham.gov.uk/threefouryearold

Contact providers directly to register your child. You can register a term ahead to reserve a place.

3 AND 4 YEAR OLD EARLY EDUCATION AND CHILDCARE - 30 HOURS FREE PER WEEK

3 and 4-year-olds may be entitled to 30 hours free childcare per week.

The additional 15 hours is available to families where both parents are working (or the sole parent is working in a lone parent family), and each parent earns a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at national minimum wage or living wage, and less than £100,000 per year. This also includes self-employed parents.
